

Examples of 'In Scope' and 'Out of Scope' carriageway defects for Member Led Pothole Repair Programme

Illustrated below are examples of the sort of potholes we can deal with under this Member Led Repair Programme followed by examples of works that fall outside the scope of the scheme, which we will not be able to repair.

'In Scope' works include:

- **Potholes** - Clustered approach allows us to repair more defects in a crew day.



- **Clustered Repairs** - This reduces the crews travelling time which allows more works to be delivered.



‘Out of Scope’ Carriageway Works:

These types of problem will not be considered for repair under this programme. Please do not list such problems as part of this scheme.

- Roads that require major reconstruction – Large failure of concrete bays.



- Roads requiring major Carriageway Resurfacing – This would need a machine laid surface.



- Asphalt Delamination on Concrete – This requires specialist repair works.
